

Discussion questions:

Read Luke 10:25-37. What question did the lawyer ask in v. 29?

In v. 36, what question did Jesus ask? Why do you think Jesus changed the question around?

Share about a time when it was hard simply to be available for others. How can we balance our time with our families, work, and other commitments so that we can have to be available to others?

Tell us about a time when loving someone else was messy. Why was it worth it? Do you wish you would have been able to do more?

What do you think being "intentional" our neighbors (the others) looks like? How can we become more intentional with the people God has uniquely put in our lives?

Ask God to show you how to make the most of every opportunity with the people he's put in your life. Wisely use the moments you have with your family to teach them about God and how they can follow him. Intentionally invest in others, even when it is messy. What will you have to change in your weekly routine in order to love "the others" God has placed in your life.
