6. Read Hebrews 4:15. Why is this verse encouraging? My main point this week was that “Jesus entered the world as a baby so that he could fully identify with us in every aspect of our humanity in order to be fully qualified to be our Savior.” Do you think Jesus could have “saved us” from our sin if he had come as an adult instead of as a child? Explain your answer. What impact might it have on our lives if we really believed Jesus understood everything we’ve gone through?
